Animals with large ears, slightly arched face slightly arched, with uncovered chest, with a lively look. In the female, the udder is very well developed, with a fine, well irrigated skin.

BREED STANDARD

Head

- Elongated, dolichocephalic type, thin without jar, open
- Narrow and elongated face
- Profile slightly convex to convex
- Dolichocephalic skull
- Medium forehead
- Orbital arches not very pronounced
- Nasal bridge sometimes pink and slightly wrinkled in rams
- Ears long, not very thick, broad at the base, carried almost horizontally
- Open cheeks
- Colour of the face white with the possibility of slightly shiny reflections

Wool

- White in colour, fine 2/3
- The closed fleece covers the whole body from
- the legs to the knees and hocks, the neck to the nape of the neck.

- **Fine**
- Crease-free
- Large surface area
- Some brown spots may be present on the face, ears and mucous membranes

Chest

- Broad and harmonious
- Deep chest, free of wool in adults
- Well built withers
- Long back which may be concave
- Muscular loins
- Muscular and regular underside
- Rump wide and long, slightly sloping to sloping
- Long and voluminous leg

Neckline

Long without exaggeration

Members

Long, thin, all-white, wiry with regular legs

Eliminating defects

- Presence of horns
- Presence of tufting
- Black spots
- Insufficient development
- Defects in legs
