



ROMANOV

Head

- Small and angular
- The skull is rounded
- The ears are erect and mobile
- The eyes are large
- Males have a more rounded muzzle than females and a broader, shorter head

Body

- Medium size
- The ribs are round
- High legged animal

Weights

- Rams : 80 to 150 kg
- Ewes : 65 to 90 kg

The Romanov (or Finnish) breed has a very particular phenotype

BREED STANDARD

Wool

- Black at birth
- It then appears bluish grey due to a mixture of black hair and very fine white wool
- Males have a mane of long black hair around the neck and dewlap

Tail

- Short and tapered, averaging 13 cm in length

Eliminating defects

- Insufficient development
- Docked tail
- Severe defects
- Horns
- Defective legs
